## *Family And Community Treatment*

*A comprehensive, home-based treatment service partnering with youth and families to strengthen their abilities and create lasting change.*

FACT is an intensive home-based service requested by families with multiple service needs. The resources and skills of a multi-disciplinary team are available to each youth and family.

FACT Services are youth and family-centered and build on the youth and family strengths to increase personal and community supports, promote healthy family functioning, support and preserve families and reduce the need for out-of-home placement.

FACT provides comprehensive treatment partnering therapeutic and case management services for the entire family, offering flexible scheduling and a variety of treatment services including: family and individual therapy, couples counseling, substance abuse treatment, parenting support, group treatment and play therapy.

Using a Wraparound approach, FACT works with the entire family to coordinate and monitor services and supports within community, educational, legal, and medical systems by:

- Using a strength-based, needs-driven approach
- Encouraging youth and family choice throughout service involvement
- Helping youth and families identify and build relationships with natural supports
- Providing advocacy, community-based referrals, and support
- Partnering with youth and families to create and sustain community involvement
