- Advocacy, referral, and support within community and educational systems.
- Coordination of psychiatric services.
- A variety of clinical interventions including evidence based models.
- Family support services focused on community integration.

Family & Children Services is a private, nonprofit, nonsectarian, human service organization begun in the early 1900's. Its mission has remained constant "...To support, strengthen and preserve the safety, well being and dignity of children, individuals and families".

The agency receives funding through allocations from local United Ways, contracts with Community Mental Health programs and the Michigan Department of Human Services, insurance reimbursements, fees for service based on a sliding scale and contributions. We are accredited by the Council on Accreditation of Services for Families and Children.

A comprehensive, home-based treatment service partnering with youth and families to strengthen their abilities and create lasting change.

FACT is an intensive home-based service requested by families with multiple service needs. The resources and skills of a multi-disciplinary team are available to each youth and family.

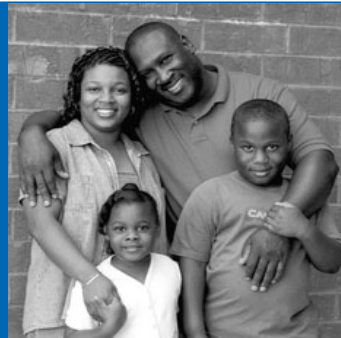
FACT Services are youth and family-centered and build on the youth and family strengths to increase personal and community supports, promote healthy family functioning, support and preserve families and reduce the need for out-of-home placement.

FACT provides case management services for the entire family, offering flexible scheduling and a variety of treatment services including: family and individual therapy, couples counseling, substance abuse treatment, parenting support, group treatment and play therapy.

Using a Wraparound approach, FACT works with the entire family to coordinate and monitor services and supports within community, educational, legal, and medical systems by:

- Using a strength-based, needs-driven approach
- Encouraging youth and family choice throughout service involvement
- Helping youth and families identify and build relationships with natural supports
- Providing advocacy, community-based referrals, and support
- Partnering with youth and families to create and sustain community involvement
